Please note the following change in Immunohistochemical (IHC) reporting for breast tumor biomarkers effective January 1, 2024

The initial breast cancer diagnosis and all IHC results to include ER, PR and/or HER-2/Neu, will be combined on one comprehensive report titled Anatomic Pathology Report. Any IHC results will be reported as an addendum on the original anatomic pathology report DPMG will no longer issue a separate IHC report. We expect this change will optimize the ease of use as all relevant and pertinent information can be accessed on one report.

<u>SMG EPIC users</u> - The IHC results will be available as an addendum at the bottom of the initial surgical pathology report in the PATH tab. A separate IHC report will not be issued. A notification will be sent via EPIC when an addendum is made available.
